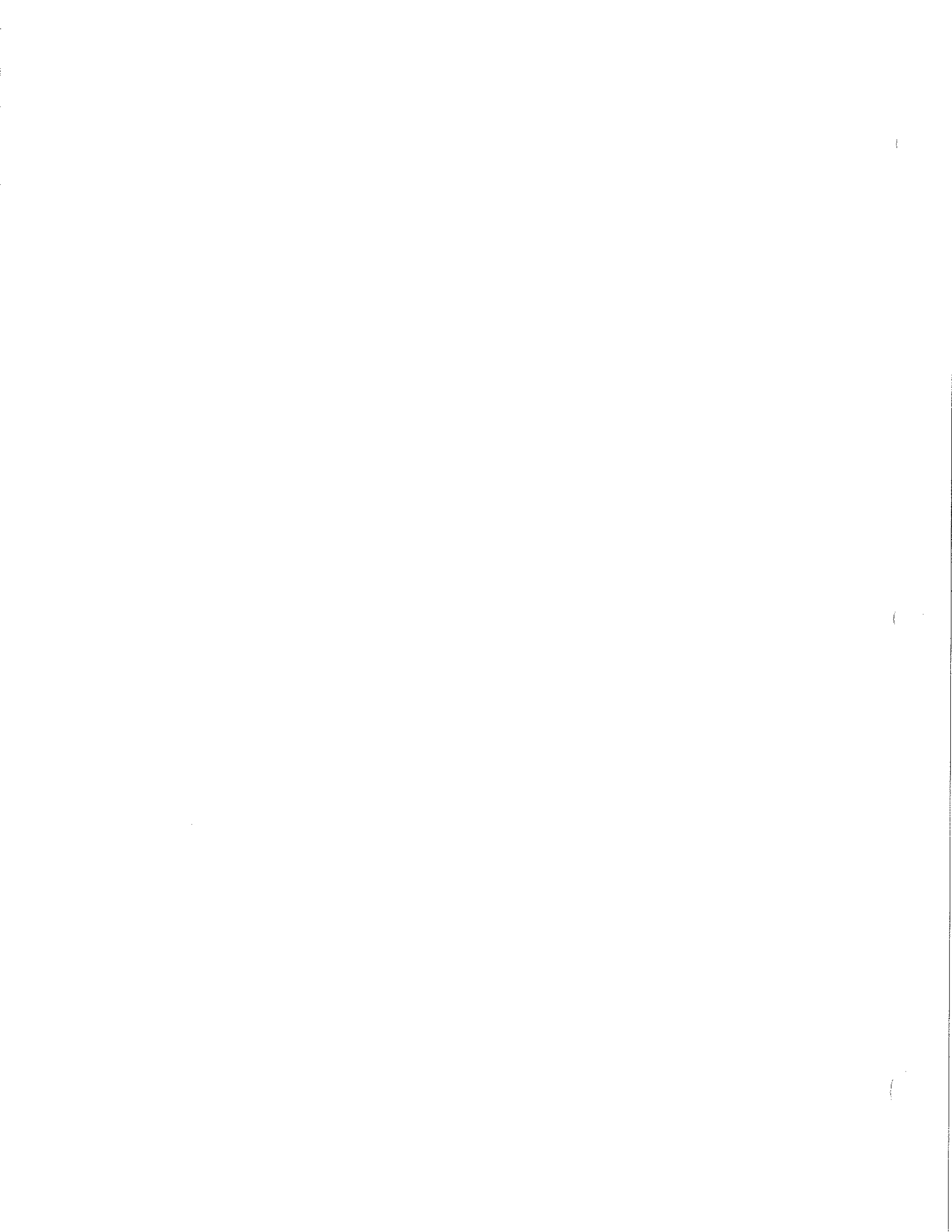


What is CBI?

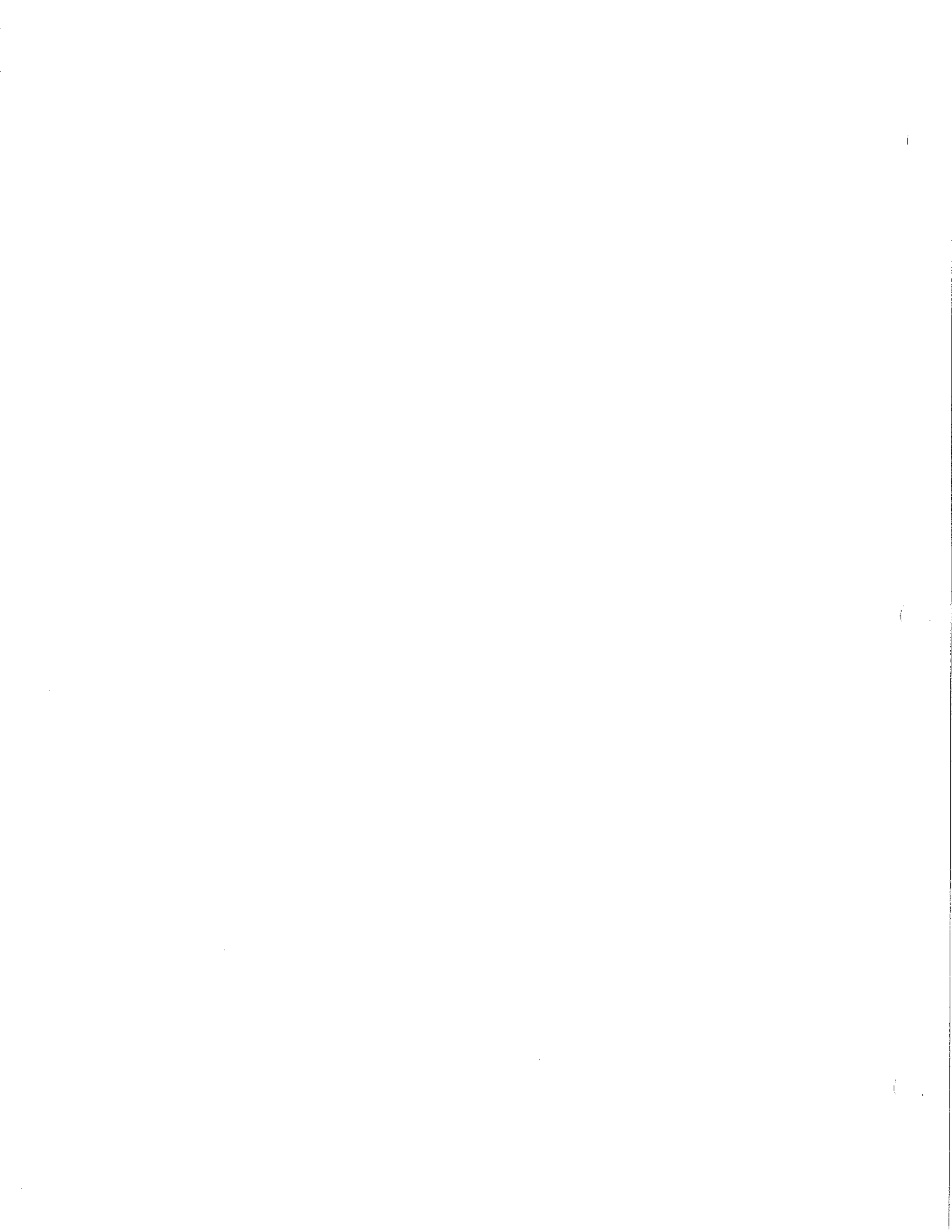
